Frequently Asked Questions on the Arlington Collegiate Academy

1. If my student was in the Scholars program, are they automatically in the Collegiate Academy?

The Collegiate Academy is open to all rising 9th graders through the application process. All rising 10th graders who are currently Arlington Scholars will be transferred over to the Arlington Collegiate Academy and must meet all requirements of the Arlington Collegiate Academy.

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Rising 11th & 12th grade students who are Arlington Scholars will not be enrolled in the Arlington Collegiate Academy and will remain Arlington Scholars and will continue to meet all the requirements in that program to obtain the Honors Diploma.

2. Can transfer students apply to the Arlington Collegiate Academy?

Yes. All new rising 9th & 10th grade students to Arlington High School can apply to the Arlington Collegiate Academy. All new rising 11th grade students to Arlington High School can apply to the Arlington Scholars program.

3. How is the Collegiate Academy different from the Scholars program?

The Collegiate Academy is different from the Scholars program in that the focus is to allow our students the opportunity to obtain as many potential college credits and leadership/career opportunities during high school, getting a jump start on their college careers allowing for a quicker transition to their career and life goals.

4. What about requirements for acceptance to Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Dual Credit, and Honors courses?

Students accepted & enrolled in the Arlington Collegiate Academy must follow all guidelines for acceptance to college level courses and must be aware of the requirements that many universities require before students can be admitted to a university or college. Arlington Community Schools makes no guarantees of college transfer credit between universities outside the university in which the credit was obtained.

5. When is the deadline to apply for the CA?

The first-round applicants will be notified of an interview by March 6. After the March interviews take place, additional interview dates will be made as needed for new students.

6. Do current Arlington Scholars have to apply for CA?

Current Arlington Scholars in 9th grade this year will be rolled over to the Collegiate Academy and do not have to apply. Current 10th and 11th grade Arlington Scholars will not be rolled over to the Arlington Collegiate Academy but will remain Arlington Scholars and work toward the Honors Diploma.

7. How do I go to the School Board Meetings?

A schedule of annual school board meetings will be provided to Collegiate Academy students each year. From there, students will determine which school board meetings they want to attend. A minimum of one per year must be attended.

8. LEAD Arlington meetings are by invite only. How will we be able to attend those?

Students will be assigned to attend 2 LEAD Arlington Meetings while enrolled in the Academy.

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
